## Changes to our catalogue...

We have recently integrated our digital library (eBooks, eAudiobooks) with our regular books. Now when you search our Jonny Apples eed catalogue you will see titles in various formats. 2018

As an example, the Canada Reads book Jonny Appleseed is offered four different ways. Through the Hoopla platform it is

always available for download. Click and download. Make sure you set up an account using your library card number and email. You have a limit of 3 Hoopla titles each month.

The eBook version is also available on OverDrive (also accessible via the Libby app). This is a shared resource with other libraries and you can add your name to the waiting list. OverDrive also has the audiobook version available.

If holding a physical book in your hands is your preferred method of reading this title, you can do that too. In this instance, the title is currently unavailable, but you can reserve it and you will receive email notification (or phone call) when it's available for Curbside pickup.

To log into your account or set up an account to access digital copies you need your 6 digit library card number. The default password is your last name (first letter is uppercase). If you need assistance with any of our platforms, just give us a call during business hours. If you need to renew or update your membership, you can do that online.

Here are a few other helpful hints about our catalogue:

The home screen of the catalogue features the last 200 items added to the collection. This includes materials we have placed on order. You can reserve directly from this screen by simply clicking on the title.

You can log into your account to view items out on your card and renew them (as long as no one else is waiting for them). You can manage reserves including suspending a title if you want to wait to sign it out. Suspension ensures you don't lose your place in the reserve list when you reactivate it. You can also check your loan history. The default search parameter is by "relevance". You can change this setting to author, title, keyword etc.



When searching the catalogue, you can refine your results to provide you with various types of formats. In this example James Patterson is available in a variety of ways. Select your desired format and refresh your search.
